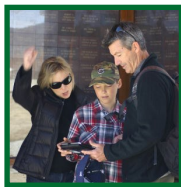
### Amazing Scavenger Hunt Adventure

### #HikeItUpBigBear Cougar Crest Trail

**Moderate To Difficult**  
**2 miles one way**  
**Elevation Gain: 750 feet**  
**Time:** Dawn to Dusk **Cost:** Free



A well-maintained trail through a wide variety of natural environments. You'll see wildflowers, cacti and twisted juniper trees spiraling toward the sky with beautiful views of Big Bear Lake from the top. It starts 0.6 of a mile west of the Discovery Center on HWY 38. In the first mile there's only a gentle uphill increase, but within the second mile you'll realize that you're gaining serious altitude. The trail gets rockier towards the top so wear good shoes and mind your footing. The Cougar Crest Trail ends at the junction of the Pacific Crest Trail. This trailhead requires an Adventure Pass for parking in the designated lot. Adventure Pass is \$5 and can be purchased at the Discovery Center or the Big Bear Visitors Center in the Village.
